Dharmsoka College Past Pupils' Association – Colombo Branch Trust

The Trust formulated in 1996 with the prime objective of promoting the advancement of education of students of Dharmasoka College, by providing scholarships to needy students entering any State University in Sri Lanka. The Trust has been developed based on voluntary donations offered by our past pupils and well-wishers and has so far awarded over 500 scholarships.

The present scholarship grant is Rs.60,000/- in total for three years and disbursements were made through funds derived from Bank interest accrued on the "Special Fund", kept as Fixed Deposits in banks consists of donations by several benefactors. In addition to this arrangement, individual one-time donations too were received to the value of a scholarship (Rs. 60,000/=) for a period of three years.

Trust greatly appreciates Mr. G.L. De Silva's family for establishing G L De Silva Memorial Special Fund to present a gold sovereign engraved with the college crest for the Academic Performer of the year. Mrs. Kawshalya De Silva daughter of late Mr. R G L De Silva, donated Rs. 1.3 million to the Scholarship Fund. It will be used to give 2 scholarships annually for a female student & male student.
